1	A-X X X-C	Enter ordinary trot rising Halt five seconds Proceed, ordinary trot; track right	
2	B	Circle, passing through X Ordinary trot to K	
3	KXM M	Extend the trot Ordinary trot	
4	H E-H H	Half circle in reverse Slow trot, sitting, Ordinary trot, rising	
5	HCM	Trot fence off track	
6	B F-A K	Halt; walk forward on loose reins Establish contact Canter, right lead	
7	E	Circle, passing through X	
8	C-A A	Serpentine of four loops (between first and second loops, simple change of lead; between second and third loops, simple change of lead through the walk; between third and fourth loops flying change of lead) Track left	
9	FXH	Change direction over two jumps (set from three to five strides apart) flying change of lead on landing if necessary	
10	F	Short turn on haunches at canter Canter to M	
11	M	Halt; back four steps; proceed canter left lead	
12	E K	Slow canter; circle, passing through X Ordinary Canter	
13	F E	Gallop Ordinary canter	
14	A X	Turn down center Halt five seconds Leave ring on loose reins
