6	E	Half circle in reverse with flying change of lead on diagonal line	
7	F B	Ordinary trot rising Turn left	
8	X E	Halt; five seconds; back 4 steps; trot rising Track right	
9	C-M MBF	Leave track to approach fence Take trotting fence Ordinary trot to A	
10	A K F	Canter, right lead Gallop Canter	
11	A X C	Turn down center Simple change of lead through the walk Track left	
12	E K	Slow canter; circle, passing through X Ordinary Canter	
13	FXH	Change direction over two jumps (set from three to five strides apart)	
14	M M-B F	Ordinary trot Gradually go to loose reins Establish Contact	
15	A K	Walk Lengthen the walk	
16	H	Ordinary walk; half turn on haunches Walk to E	
17	E A	Canter, left lead Turn down center
