#### ***Owen Results of the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual ANRC National Intercollegiate Championship***

The 25<sup>th</sup> Annual ANRC National Intercollegiate Championship was held on April 20 & 21 and hosted by St. Andrews Presbyterian College in Laurinburg, North Carolina.

Judges for this year=s competition were Patty Heuckeroth from Southern Pines, North Carolina, and Cindy Ross from Tryon, North Carolina. Twelve colleges competed in the three phases, and there were 61 competitors. Each team and each individual received a score in each phase. The three phases included Dressage Sportif (40%), a program ride composed of hunter seat equitation movements; a Hunter Trials Equitation Course (30%) over cross-country type jumps; and a Hunter Seat Equitation Course (30%) in a ring. Each rider also competed as an individual in the Written Phase, although these results did not affect the overall score.

The Overall Team winner was St. Andrew=s Presbyterian College, coached by Peggy McElveen and Debbi White. Second was the University of Virginia, coached by Claiborne Bishop and Jon Conyers. Closely following, in third through sixth place, respectively, were Savannah College of Arts and Design, Virginia Intermont College, Sweet Briar College, and Goucher College.

Jennifer James, St. Andrew=s Presbyterian College, was the winner of the Overall Individual Competition. Second and third were Frank Bria and Kria Petr, both of St. Andrew=s; followed by Lauren Richardson and Rebecca Glover, representing University of Virginia; and in sixth place was Kate Fournel of Goucher College.

Additional schools participating were: Centenary College, College of William and Mary, Otterbein College, The College of Charleston, The University of the South, and Wesleyan College.
